A standing couple straddles a woman lying on a concrete beach in Chicago; he's tugging at his skimpy swimsuit, and the trio of open limbs implies a rollicking threesome. These vintage black-and-white prints from the 1970s also include shots of bare feet strolling the sensuously curving edge of a swimming pool and a garish painting of a centerfold babe abandoned on the sidewalk.
